ARTICLE 22 SECTION (1)**

**CRIMINAL PROVISIONS
VIOLATION SANCTIONS**

1. Any person who intentionally and without rights announces or reproduces a Work or grants a permit for it, shall be punished with a minimum imprisonment of 1 (one) month and/or a minimum fine of Rp. 1,000,000.00 (one million rupiah), or a maximum imprisonment of 7 (seven) years and/or a maximum fine of Rp. 5,000,000,000.00 (five billion rupiah).
2. Whoever intentionally delivers, broadcasts, exhibits, distributes, or sells to the public a Work or goods resulting from a Copyright or Related Rights infringement as referred to in paragraph (1), shall be sentenced to a maximum imprisonment of 5 (five) years and/or a maximum fine of Rp. 500,000,000.00 (five hundred million rupiah).
